Dr. Steffen Künn studied economics at the Free University Berlin (Germany) and at the Loughborough University (UK). He received his Master degree in April 2008. Afterwards he started his PhD studies in economics and received his PhD from the University of Potsdam in 2012. His main research interests include applied labor economics and in particular the evaluation of labor market policy. Beside the evaluation of traditional programs of active labor market policy (such as wage subsidies, training etc), he is particularly interested in the effectiveness of programs which aim at promoting self-employment among the unemployed. Dr. Steffen Künn is currently a Senior Research Associate and Deputy Program Director for the "Evaluation" program area at IZA.



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Alexander Spermann is Director of Labor Policy Germany at IZA Bonn. He has been Privatdozent (brit. Senior lecturer, am. He studied economics at the Universities of Passau and Freiburg (Diploma 1988) and finished his doctorate at the University of Freiburg in 1992.
